Held charge of important Districts of Haryana, on reallocation, to Haryana till 1975, Held charge of District Gurgaon from 1969 to 1970 and then from 1970 to 1974 that of Hisar. Thereafter, was A.I.G. GRP. On promotion as DIG, worked as DIG, Admn & Trg. and later as Range DIG of Hisar and Ambala.

Went on deputation to the BSF at the end of 1977 and served in both J&K and Punjab till June 1981, when posted to BSF Hqrs. as DD Trg. DD Admn., and DD Prov. respectively till 1984. Promoted as IG BSF Kashmir at Srinagar. In February 1986, deputed to RPF in the Northern Railways as Chief Security Officer. Proceeded to Chandigarh on promotion as DGP, Haryana in November 1986.

In September 1987, selected by the MHA to go as DGP Nagaland and after a one-year extension of deputation, relinquished charge in September 1990. Joined as DG, Civil Defense and Home Guards in 1991 and attained superannuation on 30 November 1992.
