12	Other notable achievements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. As Addl. SP, Ludhiana, he smashed a very big spying. Also arrested Pakistan paratroopers during war with Pakistan in 1965. 2. As Commandant, HAP at Durgapur (Dec 1969 to May 1971) and on deputation to West Bengal for law & order duty he raised CISF at Durgapur and got it inducted in Durgapur Steel Plant for the first time. It is one of the biggest force. 3. Apprehended extremists at Durgapur and established law and order in West Bengal, particularly in Burdwan district, due to which an elected Government was formed. 4. Made security arrangements for Smt. Indira Gandhi at Bhadreswar near Calcutta when the West Bengal Police was unable to extend security cover due to extremists threats. 5. He acquired 212 acres of land at Madhuban, Karnal where big HAP campus has been established. 6. Opened two schools at Ambala and Hisar in Police Line. 7. Established Traffic Aid Posts on National Highways in 1982 for the first time which has been followed by the Ministry of Transport. 8. Introduced Prisoners' Reform in Jails in Haryana. 9. Ordered not to summon children, old/senior citizens and women at Police Stations and got stopped Traffic checking on roads by Police.
